

FIG. 44—KAN CROSS, YAX, AND COMPLETION SIGNS
ASSOCIATED WITH SNAKES AND WATER (?)

1. Stream of water (?) with completion sign on it which falls from long-nosed god with death markings in hand of figure. Pal. Cross, west side of entrance to sanctuary.
2. Stream of water (?) with kan cross and completion sign. Quir. H.
3. Stream of water (?) with kan cross and Yax symbol alternating. Yax. 7.
4. Stream of water (?) with kan cross falling from vessel (?) decorated with glyphic element held by long-nosed monster. Quir. P.
5. Part of snake with body formed of yax signs alternating with jade beads and with what may be shell element at back of head. Pal. Cross.
6. Head of two-headed snake with yax and bone elements. Tik. T 4, L 3.
7. Yax ornament with shell outline and jade bead with bone appendages attached to body of snake belonging with no. 6. Tik. T 4, L 3.
8. Fretlike upper jaw of serpent with kan cross attached. Pal. Palace, House D, Pier C.
